

Weak Investor Sentiment Dragged the Key Index Lower

- All major indexes closed in the negative today, as bearish bias continues for the third day in a row.
- The NGX ASI and the Market Capitalization both closed in the negative by 0.06% to settle at 51,556.54 points and №27.79 trillion.
- Investors' sentiment as measured by market breadth was neutral at 1.00x, with 16 stocks closing in the positive and 16 stocks closing in the negative.
- Market performance in terms of total volume and value of deals was negative. Total volume traded reduced by 42.35% to 135.26 million units while the value of transactions reduced by 44.02% to ₹1.44 billion.
- TRANSCORP shares was the most actively traded as the volume printed at 15.55 million units, followed by GTCO with 13.11 million units and UPDC with 11.97 million units.
- GTCO led the value chart with №267.09 million followed by AIRTELAFRI with №210.98 million and ZENITHBANK with №156.98 million.
- ACADEMY topped the gainers list for the day increasing by 9.79% followed by CHIPLC and JAPAULGOLD both appreciating by 8.70% and 7.41% respectively.
- On the flip side, CHAMPION led the losers' chart depreciating by 10.00% followed by NEM and UBN declining by 10.00% and 9.76% respectively.

What to Expect Tomorrow?

• We envisage that activities might remain bearish at Thursday's trading session as the current macroeconomic climate continue to dampen investor sentiment.



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Glossary

- **NGX ASI:** shows the changing average value of the share prices of all companies on the Nigerian Stock Exchange. It also tracks the general market movement of all listed equities on Nigerian Exchange and is used as a measure of how well a market is performing.
- Market Capitalization: refers to the total Naira market value of a company's outstanding shares of stock. Commonly referred to as "market cap," it is calculated by multiplying the total number of a company's outstanding shares by the current market price of one share.
- Market Breadth: is computed on the stock market by taking the ratio of the number of advancing stocks to declining stocks.
- **Bullish:** means that a market will experience an upward price movement.
- **Bearish:** means you believe that a market, asset or financial instrument is going to experience a downward trajectory.
- Basis Point (bps): refers to a common unit of measure for interest rates and other percentages in finance. One basis point is equal to 0.01%.
- Large Cap Stocks: are also known as largely capitalized stocks. The are stocks that have a significant market share.
- · Cherry Picking: the action or practice of choosing and taking only the most beneficial or profitable opportunities.

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
