



Equities Market Update

26 July 2022

MTNN Sinks the Index Again Declining by 9.6%

- The equity market was red today as only three stocks closed in the positive, due to sell pressure across the board.
- The NGX ASI and the Market Capitalization both closed in the negative by **1.86%** to settle at 50,442.37 points and ₦27.20 trillion, respectively.
- Investors' sentiment as measured by market breadth was negative at 0.08x, with **3** stocks closing in the **positive** and **37** stocks closing in the **negative**. The year to date (YTD) return moved to **18.09%**.
- Market performance in terms of total volume and value of deals were positive. Total volume and value increased by **57.98%** and **16.78%** to 156.17 million units and ₦2.94 billion, respectively.
- FLOURMILL shares was the most actively traded as the volume printed at 19.32 million units, followed by TRANSCORP with 15.40 million units and GTCO with 12.69 million units.
- FLOURMILL led the value chart with ₦618.05 million followed by MTNN with ₦576.54 million and AIRTELAFRI with ₦336.78 million.
- LIVESTOCK topped the gainers list for the day appreciating by **1.63%** followed by FBNH and STERLNBANK appreciating by **1.36%** and **1.32%** respectively.
- On the flip side, TRANSEXPR led the losers' chart depreciating by **10.00%** followed by INTBREW and MTNN declining by **9.91%** and **9.62%** respectively.

What to Expect Tomorrow?

- We expect the sell pressure to continue at Wednesday's trading session as investors exit the equities market for safer haven.

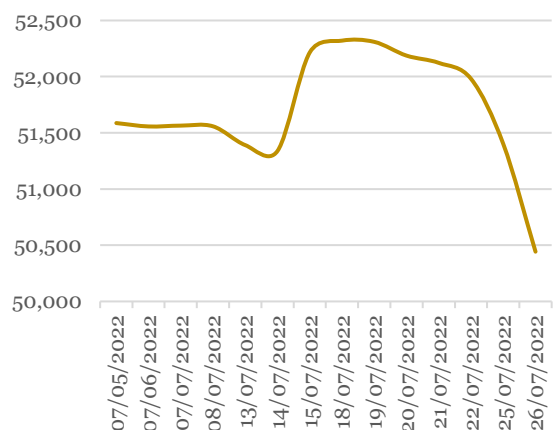

Glossary

- **NGX ASI:** shows the changing average value of the share prices of all companies on the Nigerian Stock Exchange. It also tracks the general market movement of all listed equities on Nigerian Exchange and is used as a measure of how well a market is performing.
- **Market Capitalization:** refers to the total Naira market value of a company's outstanding shares of stock. Commonly referred to as "market cap," it is calculated by multiplying the total number of a company's outstanding shares by the current market price of one share.
- **Market Breadth:** is computed on the stock market by taking the ratio of the number of advancing stocks to declining stocks.
- **Bullish:** means that a market will experience an upward price movement.
- **Bearish:** means you believe that a market, asset or financial instrument is going to experience a downward trajectory.
- **Basis Point (bps):** refers to a common unit of measure for interest rates and other percentages in finance. One basis point is equal to 0.01%.
- **Large Cap Stocks:** are also known as largely capitalized stocks. They are stocks that have a significant market share.
- **Cherry Picking:** the action or practice of choosing and taking only the most beneficial or profitable opportunities.
